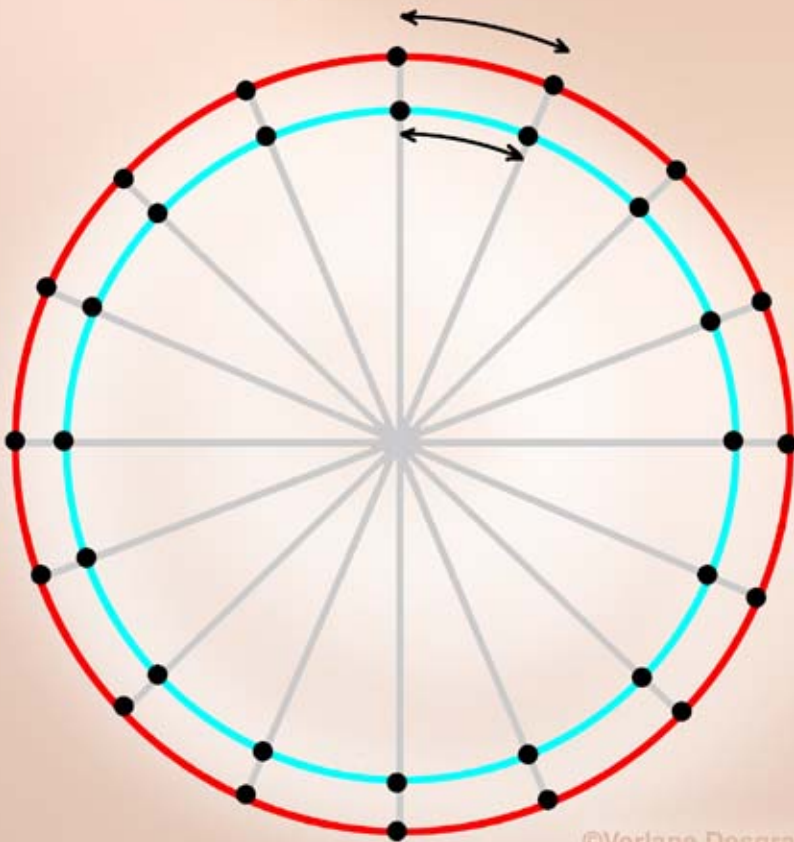


Layout for

circular applique



Inner holes to be punched will be closer together than holes around outside. This way you don't have to go through the same hole 2-3 times to "catch up" with your lace pattern.

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Black dots represent punch holes. Arrows show holes are spaced further apart on "outside" circle (red). You will have many more holes than is shown here, but the lesser number was shown for clarity. Illustration at right shows sample layout superimposed on a carving design. Eyeball the spacing or use a compass. Always begin with the inner circle (blue) first. Then add the "outside" circle (red).
